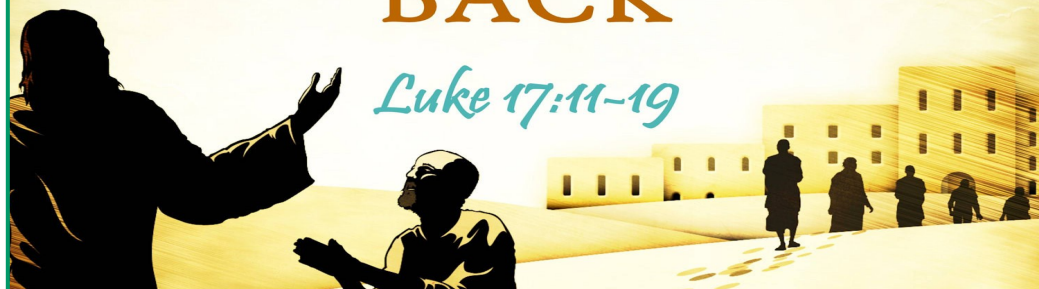

Joseph's Workbench

As most of the parish know I caught COVID on September 23rd, a Friday, and was out of action for two weekends. It wasn't until eleven days later that I had tested negative and was able to celebrate Mass again on Tuesday, October 4th, the feast of St. Francis of Assisi.

My experience of COVID was difficult and there were two main difficulties. The first was the physical ordeal. I was sneezing, sniffing, and coughing because of severe congestion. I was very tired and for the first few days did a lot of sleeping. I took some medications, Nyquil mostly, which helped. I dread to think how much more severe the illness would have been if I had not been vaccinated and boosted! The severe symptoms abated after about five days, but that brought me to the second difficulty.

Isolation was difficult. I am a hospital chaplain as well as a pastor and I knew that I needed to quarantine, but that isolation from everyone was hard. I like my own company and don't mind being alone, but to be that way all the time was difficult. I missed seeing everyone, going to Mass, visiting people in the hospitals, even doing funerals! Prayer helped a lot, but knowing Mass was going on and I wasn't there was painful. I missed Mass, the great encounter with God and God's people. In other words, I missed you guys! I streamed our Mass, but it's not the same.

I want to thank everyone for their prayers and support. I feel bad I probably gave Deacon Nick the virus; he's doing better. Deacon Tom, Tammy, Cindy, Carol, Jodi, Kathy, Dan and all our volunteers really stepped up. Fathers, Fritzen, Alciati, Tormey, Muscalino, Clemente and Galuppi all were a great help filling in for Masses and events.

I'm so glad I will be here for this weekend, then I go on pilgrimage to Lourdes, France. I will keep all of you and your needs and intentions in my prayer at the grotto of Lourdes. Thanks be to God that I came through and thank you for all your support!
