Joseph's Workbench

A parish financial report is facts and figures, but mere dollars and cents cannot capture the essence of a church like St. Joseph's. Each report reflects the hard work of many parishioners who gave of their earnings so that we could have such a remarkable church.

Todd Klaben, our Finance Council Chairman, will give the report and do a great job, as usual. So I will just go over the spiritual aspect of the report (which I'm sure Todd will also cover).

Once again, due to the aftereffects of the COVID pandemic, we have a net loss of income that amounts to around \$135,000. Our reserves and our cost cutting have helped but it is obvious that our only way forward is to raise revenue. Further cost conscious management will continue, but we cannot significantly reduce costs without a significant loss in important parts of parish life. This means not only giving more from the people here but attracting more people.

Therefore this year we will have a stewardship campaign and an evangelization campaign as well. If we raised our giving by about 25% we would have balanced our books this year. This would be even easier if we had more people in the pews.

Yet the challenge is not a numbers game, but a spiritual one. Will our parishioners take responsibility for our parish? Will the Gospel enter into our hearts enough that we are generous givers, and openly inviting people to come here to St. Joseph's?

I invite everyone to rise to this challenge. With the decline in the number of priests I may soon be responsible for another church, as will all our other priests. Parishes will be closed. The ones that survive will be the ones that have people who have spiritually and financially taken responsibility for their parish church. I hope St. Joseph's will be among them.
