Thanksgiving is my favorite national holiday. Christmas and Easter are obviously my religious favorites, but Thanksgiving runs a close third. Perhaps it's because I was born in Massachusetts and spent my first ten summers with my grandparents and cousins in Duxbury, Mass. near Plymouth. Every summer we would visit Plymouth Rock, tour the Mayflower II and go to the Plimoth Plantation living museum. In Duxbury, home of Miles Standish there was the Miles Standish Monument, the tallest monument in world because it was "Miles above the sea!" Some minor Duxbury humor there. Jonathan and Priscilla Alden's home was down the street from my grandparent's home on St. George Street.

All that history, however, is a minor consideration next to our family love for Thanksgiving. Both my parents, especially my father, loved Thanksgiving. The turkey, Dad carving, the food, yes we had green bean casserole, and the unintentional family tradition of forgetting about the pies warming in the oven!

Prayer was also a part of the holiday. We would always have a grace thanking God for all our blessings before the dinner. We also often attended a Thanksgiving Day Mass, especially once we were living here in Central New York at St. James in Cazenovia. Later, as a priest, the Thanksgiving Mass, whether on Thanksgiving Day or the night before, has been a favorite Mass of mine.

Thankfulness is a spiritually fruitful thing. Only when we reflect on and thank God for our blessings can we find the peace and joy the world cannot take away. Thankfulness is so powerful that great saints and ordinary believers have even thanked God for their sufferings because it brings them close to the Cross of Jesus and joins them to his suffering for the salvation of the world.

One feature of my family's celebration of Thanksgiving was all of us singing "We Gather Together" together. My Dad loved that hymn, and, even though our singing was pretty sketchy, we still sang it and do sing it together every

Thanksgiving.
