UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT FOR THE NORTHERN DISTRICT OF NEW YORK

In re The Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse, New York Case No. 20-30663

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT, On June 19, 2020, The Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse, New York, ("Diocese") filed for protection under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code").

The court has established January 17, 2023 at 11:59 p.m. (prevailing Eastern time) (the "Supplemental Bar Date") as the deadline to assert claims against the Diocese arising from or relating to abuse that occurred when the survivor was 18 years of age or older, and which, prior to the enactment of the Adult Survivors Act (S.66A/A.648A) would have been subject to a statute of limitations defense ("Adult Claims").

If you have an Adult Claim against the Diocese you must file a claim on or before the Supplemental Bar Date, which will be treated confidentially in accordance with prior court orders in this Case. Please visit https://case.stretto.com/dioceseofsyracuse or call (855) 329-4244 for more information on how to file your proof of claim.

IF YOU DO NOT TIMELY FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM, YOU MAY FORFEIT YOUR RIGHT TO VOTE ON ANY PLAN OF REORGANIZATION AND TO SHARE IN ANY DISTRIBUTIONS TO CREDITORS IN CONNECTION WITH THE DIOCESE'S CHAPTER 11 CASE.

Eileen Dailey is this year's recipient of the Immaculata Award! The award was established by Bishop Robert Cunningham as a way to honor volunteers in all our parishes here in the Diocese of Syracuse. Bishop Lucia will award the beautiful medals, which have an image of Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception. The presentation will be this Sunday, December 4th in the Cathedral here in Syracuse. The ceremony includes prayer, music and the bishop personally giving the medals to each recipient (or a representative).

Eileen is a constant presence here at the church office, lending a hand with anything that needs doing. Before Sister Ellen retired for the second time, she and Eileen worked side by side and I often mixed up their names since they seemed like two hands of the same body! Sister Ellen still volunteers once or twice a week, and they still work well together.

Eileen helps with bereavement ministry, meeting with mourning families to plan funerals, and with ministry to the homebound, matching up ministers of communion with people who cannot get to Mass. She alerts me when someone wants me to stop in their home for Anointing or Reconciliation.

Eileen is from St. Paul's in Oswego, now Christ the Good Shepherd Parish. She worked in education for years before retiring. Maria Regina College, Chapman University's extension program at the Air National Guard Airbase, and Mohawk Valley Community College were all stages in her interesting career. Before moving to Camillus, she was a parishioner at St. John the Baptist in Syracuse.

We are so grateful to God for the gift of Eileen and all she does to help this community. Thank you, Eileen, and congratulations!

On a different note, some of you may have noticed that St. Francis is missing from his place above the church fishpond. One of our recent high wind days toppled St. Francis into the pond! This was not his first tumble and he had been patched a few times. This statue has been retired and a generous donor has enabled us to order a new statue that will soon be installed in the garden. We will let you know when we will dedicate the new statue.


