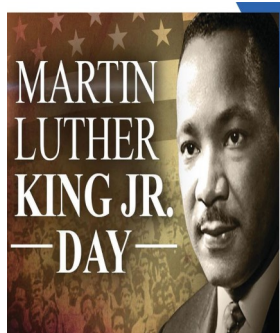

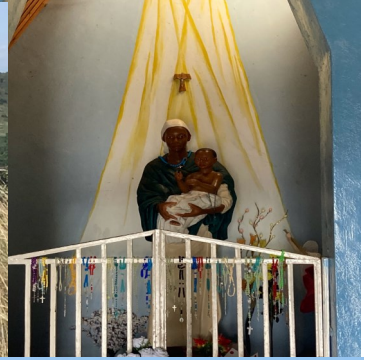
**Parish Service for Our
