
## **Parish Ministry for Our Homebound Parishioners**

# Joseph's Workbench

How does God call us? It's not always as we expect. I recall Don Whiting, a deacon of our diocese whose funeral was a few days ago. He enlisted in the United States Air Force as a young man. His dream was to be a pilot. He passed the physical here in Syracuse and went on for training, all set for life as a pilot. When he arrived at his training base, he had a second physical and failed it! In the time between his first physical and the second the Air Force had imposed a new test for allergies, anyone testing positive for allergies could not become a pilot.

This seemed at the time to be a catastrophe to Don. Time would prove that this setback set him on a wonderful path. Don went on to a great career in the Air Force in aviation electronics (avionics) and, eventually, recruiting. He married, had a wonderful family, and eventually became a deacon.

One of the greatest time wasters and sinkers of our spirits is the group of phrases: would've, could've, and should've. We spend so much time on what we might have done, and how things might have been, that we don't deal with the world as it is, with its many challenges and opportunities.

God calls us to follow him. We are not called on a perfect path, one with no detours, rather we are called to a faithful path. Next week is Passion Sunday, Palm Sunday. We will hear the account of the arrest, trial, torture, and death of Jesus. We will hear of Peter denying Jesus three times.

If Peter had spent his time thinking what he would have, could have, or should have done instead of denying Jesus, he might have ended up like Judas, a suicide. Instead he repented and became completely faithful to Jesus, even unto death.

We of course must learn from our mistakes, but we can't let them paralyze us. Repentance and God's forgiveness give us a way forward into a future beyond our mistakes, sins, or setbacks.


Forgiveness after repentance is not something our culture does well anymore. Cancellation is the modern remedy for sins or mistakes. A person might be sincerely sorry, but he or she is ignored, criticized, or banned on social media.

Lent and Easter are a complete rebuke of that way of thinking. We can repent, we can change, we can make a new start. We cannot escape our past, but like Deacon Don after his rejection for pilot training, we can build a great future.

Let's do that by being people of repentance and forgiveness.
